Tutors are available on a first-come-first-served basis.

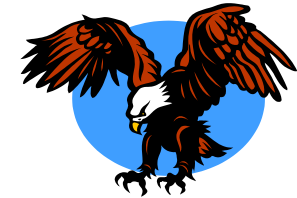
